William D. Magwood, IV

William D. Magwood, IV is a former Director of Nuclear Energy with the U.S. Department of Energy. He currently, is the President of Secure Energy North America Corporation (SENA), in Washington D.C. Mr. Magwood is working with industry and investors to develop novel approaches to finance new nuclear power stations in the United States.

Mr. Magwood was the longest-serving head of the United States Government's civilian Nuclear Technology Program, serving two Presidents and five Secretaries of Energy from May 1998 until 2005. Mr. Magwood was instrumental in shaping policy in both the Clinton and Bush Administrations regarding nuclear energy.

Mr. Magwood took a keen interest in education issues. He has established nuclear engineering program at six minority-serving institutions and pilot-tested an initiative to bring nuclear science and technology to high schools across the country.

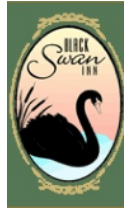
